## Loans Available to improve quality child care in Minneapolis

Is your child care center...

- located in the City of Minneapolis?
- Serving a majority of children whose families receive child care subsidies or qualify as low income?
- a Rule 3 program, licensed for at least one year?
- a Nonprofit or a For Profit business with no more than three sites?
- committed to improve the quality of your child care facility and programming?

**If you answered yes** to these questions, you may be eligible for a Renovation Loan.

Renovation loans of up to \$25,000 to improve the quality of child care environment are available to eligible Minneapolis child care centers.

Renovation Program Priorities:

- Reducing environmental health hazards
- Satisfying a citation from the City of Minneapolis
- Satisfying a correction order from a licensor
- Addressing safety issues
- Improving the quality of licensed space
- Expansion of licensed space

*Loans will not be provided for room additions.*

If you provide child care in a church, mosque, or synagogue, your program must be separately incorporated.
